"he was just at the **wrong place at the wrong time.**" - his friend

Another Loving and caring student
murdered in North London.
Another son, brother and friend lost.

Anas collapsed on the street after
running 2 blocks down the road
with a stab wound on his hips
and buttocks.
Two large Zombie Knives were found
at Chrysler park near Milton Road.
Two Teenagers both aged 17
were arrested.

“He was very quiet. He would’nt hurt anyone. He loved football and his family. He was never in any trouble, he was not in any gang or anything like that.”
The two brothers and two sisters are lost of words as to what happened to Anas.



“He was at home all day and then recieved a call saying a friend’s phone was stolen. He went to help but was attacked, his friends managed to get away.” states Anas’s brother.

A **seven year old** boy was found bringing a kitchen knife to his primary school with the intention to stab another boy at an after-school club. Teachers found the 10 inch kitchen knife in the primary school student's bag during the routine bag check in class.

The student's, teachers and his parents were truly in shock when they realised what the intentions were behind the kid bringing the knife to school .

A **six year old** was found threatening his teachers at school with a blade. "He was threatening other staff members and saying that he was going to stab me and kill me." David Simmons was truly shocked as he continued by saying, "What sort of six year old will pick up a blade and say they're going to kill me."



The maximum penalty for an adult carrying a Knife/ weapon is either **4 years** in prison, an unlimited fine or both

The number of knife or sharp instrument offences recorded by the police in London rose to approx **11,122** in 2021/22.

taken before it got too far, but the

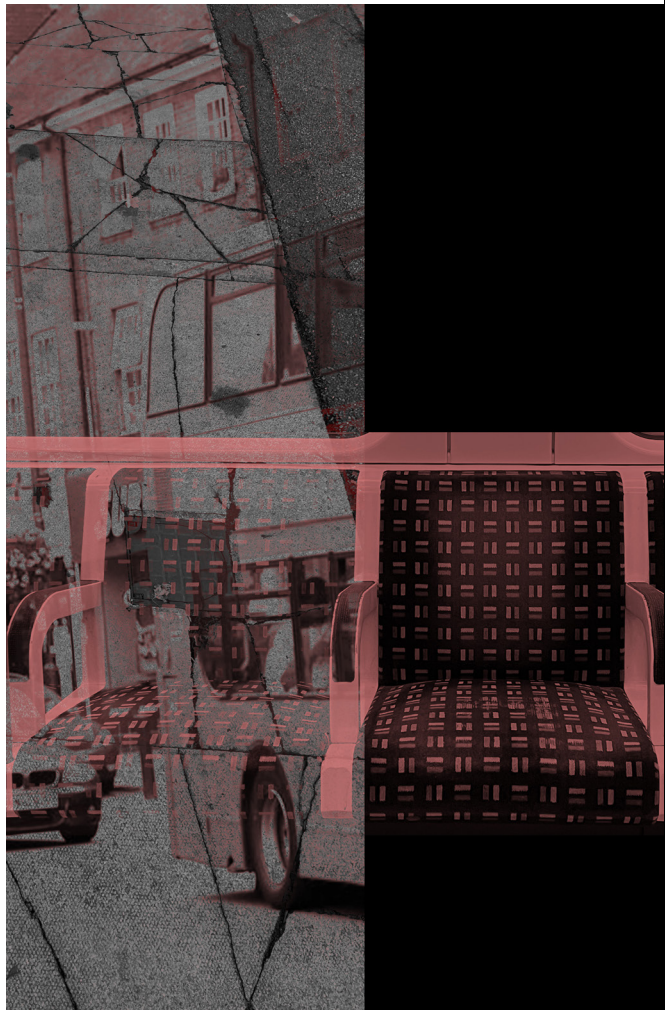
Ben still has the incident imprinted on

Ben was the new kid that at Year 8 in Secondary School was outcasted at school and bullied outside school. Ben initially denied having been approached by older boys and being threatened. He was mainly cornered outside school.



“He was **targeted and threatened**.



Ben finally admitted to having being threatened in the bus on the way to school and **feeling unsafe** outside of school too.

The older boys approached Ben and cornered him down the street on his way home with a knife. Ben was threatened to steal a mobile phone for the boys and if not they would kill him and burn down his house.



Support was given to Ben after one of his teachers found Ben crying in the boys washroom at school. The incident was immediately reported to the police, but Ben was truly traumatised by the incident. The police and the school thought it would be better for Ben to change communities for his own mental health.



TASHAN DANIEL

A vigil to tribute an aspiring athlete.

Another vigil march held for a 20 year old Arsenal Fan.

Tashan Daniel celebrated his 20th birthday and soon after the following week got stabbed.

He was on his way to an Arsenal match on a Tuesday and Lanning (the murderer) pulled out a 5.5 inch knife and stabbed Tashan mercilessly. Hundreds attended the prayer vigil and laid out various flowers signifying different ways to convey Tashan's death.

On Thursday 26th September 2019 a prayer vigil was held and Tashan's parents were truly moved by the outcome of the vigil.

"This is an amazing turnout, it really is, I don't know what to say really." says Tashan's father Chandima Daniel during the vigil speech.
